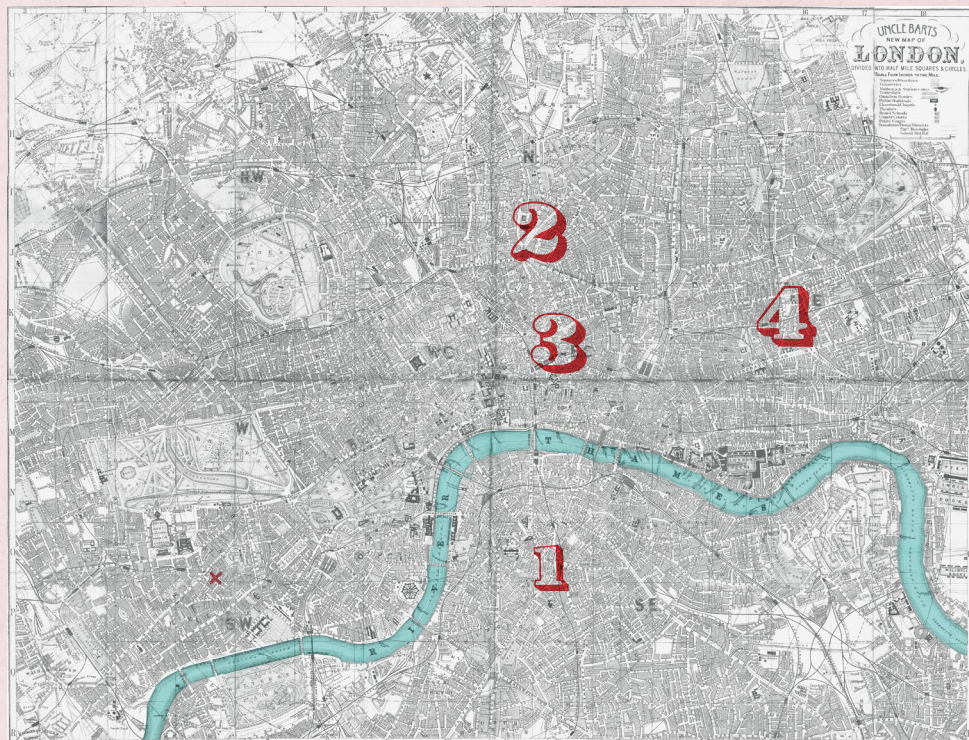

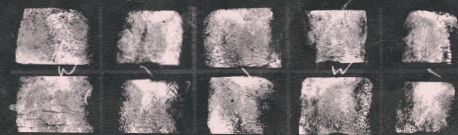
THE FORTY ELEPHANTS

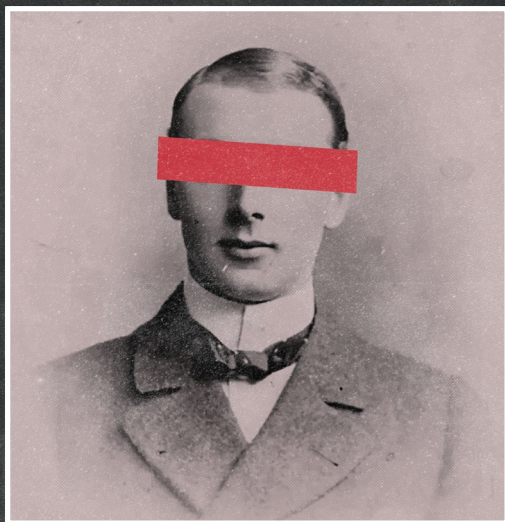

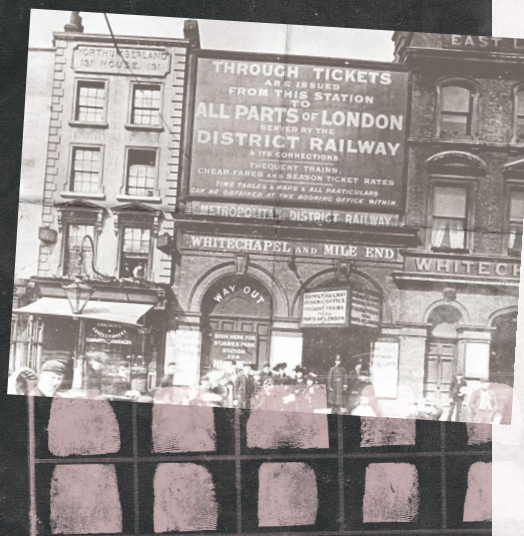

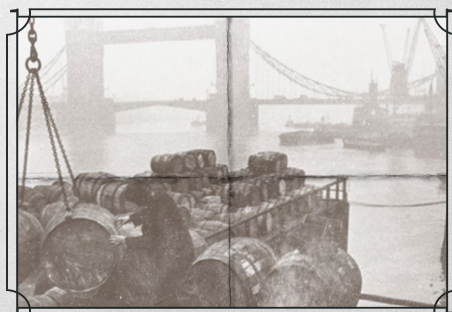
